

Search for Associate Editor, book reviews, *Central European History*

Central European History invites applications and nominations for the position of associate editor, book reviews. The new associate editor will succeed Julia S. Torrie (St. Thomas University), who has served with great enthusiasm and dedication in the position for a number of years but would now like to step down.

The appointment will commence on **July 1, 2019**. Applicants should be accomplished historians of German-speaking Central Europe employed at a North American university.

The associate editor's responsibilities include:

- Identifying new books to be reviewed; receiving and sorting books sent by publishers
- Finding and corresponding with appropriate reviewers and maintaining a database of potential reviewers
- Compiling reviews; preparing a draft table of contents of reviews for each of four annual issues
- Editing reviews; answering author queries during the publication process
- Working with the editor to generate ideas for thematic review essays and fora on particularly significant books
- Answering queries from scholars and publishers
